Kairos Outside

Many of you have probably been hearing about the Kairos ministry program, as many of our local pescadores have been participating in it in a variety of ways. The Kairos ministry is a branch of the Tres Dias movement and is structured using the Tres Dias Essentials, with some necessary modifications.

Kairos Outside is designed to support the families of men and women who are or have been incarcerated in the country's state and federal correctional facilities, as well as county jails and youth offender programs. The spouses, parents, and other relatives of the incarcerated often "do time" right along with their loved ones. It is important for them to know they are not alone and to know that there is a Christian community that cares.

This support is provided in a safe environment with Christian people during a Kairos Outside weekend. During this weekend, the guests will also have a chance to interact with other women who are in similar situations and learn how to form small groups to support and give them strength in their life's journey.

Kairos Outside Southern Indiana will host their first women's weekend October 2008. This weekend is for women 20 years of age and older, whose lives have been impacted by the incarceration of a relative/friend. We ask that you keep this ministry in your prayers, as well as the women you know who would benefit from this weekend.
